



HOME ENERGY EFFICIENCY CHECKLIST

TASKS FOR EVERY SEASON

- Clean stove hood and filters.
- Replace air filters.*
- Check windows for drafts.
- Run dishwasher cleaning cycle.
- Run oven cleaning cycle or manually clean oven.
- Adjust outdoor watering system seasonally per water utility guidelines.

SPRING

- Check toilets for leaks.
- Clean dryer lint door and trap.
- Check dryer hose for blockages.
- Trim trees and shrubs away from vents and AC units.
- Inspect and repair weatherstripping on windows and doors.
- Install insulation on garage doors.
- Schedule a summer AC tune-up.

SUMMER

- Set thermostat to 78°F when home; 85°F when away.
- Use natural ventilation during cooler times to reduce AC use.
- Install reflective window films or shades.
- Clean washing machine and detergent drawer.
- Clean refrigerator condenser coils and door seals.

AUTUMN

- Clean dryer lint door and trap.
- Check dryer hose for blockages.
- Trim trees and shrubs away from vents and AC units.
- Check toilets for leaks.
- Inspect and repair weatherstripping on windows and doors.
- Schedule furnace, boiler, or heat pump inspection and maintenance.

WINTER

- Test smoke and carbon monoxide detectors.
- Use LED holiday lighting to reduce energy consumption.
- Clean washing machine and detergent drawer.
- Clean refrigerator condenser coils and door seals.

* Can be performed more frequently, depending on product specifications.



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ENERGY SAVING TIPS – Quick Wins

- Install a programmable thermostat.
- Replace old light bulbs with LED light bulbs.
- Set refrigerator temperature between 35- and 38-degrees Fahrenheit.
- Set water heater temperature to 120-degrees Fahrenheit.
- Unplug small appliances and electronics when not in use.
- Run full loads in the dishwasher, washing machine, and dryer.
- Wash clothes in cold water (when safe for fabrics).
- Empty the dryer lint screen after every load.
- Clean dishwasher filter and spray arms weekly.
- Clean stove grates regularly.
- Change your HVAC air filters monthly (check product specifications).
- Adjust outdoor watering system seasonally per water utility guidelines.
- Schedule an AC tune-up every summer.
